



Childlife Newsletter – Catastrophy at Childlife



At around midnight on the 25th of May 2005 a violent storm devastated the entire Childlife Shelter, which currently houses 83 children. The storm destroyed the children's sleeping quarters, devastated the kitchen and eating area and blew the roofing off the toilet cubicals and shower blocks.

The Shelter's massive water tank was ripped from it's 10 meter high stand and sent flying through the air, landing like a bomb not far from the Childlife Office.

Amazingly, none of the children were seriously injured. However now the children have no shelter and no access to readily available water. Many of the children's possessions, such as their school books, have also been destroyed by the rain.
